## **Stake & Grill**

Model: GR-1522

The Stromberg Carlson Stake & Grill measures 15" wide x 22" long and includes a 36" long stake. These items are securely stored in a heavy duty nylon bag to keep things neat and tidy. Our locking handle easily slides up and down the stake to adjust the heat on your meal and also allows the grill to easily pivot away from the fire for loading and unloading of food. Hot dogs don't roll off with our up-turned edges, and our grill is heavy duty enough to perk your pot of coffee. This product is designed for many seasons of use.

- Up turned edges even keep hot dogs on the grill
- · Grill adjusts up and down stake to desired heat
- Rotates 360°
- · Chrome finish cleans easily
- Nylon bag included to keep neat and tidy

## **WARNING:**

- Use precaution during install, use, cleaning and disassembly as the grill grate is to be used over open flame and may be HOT
- When driving the grill stake into the ground, place a piece of wood between the stake head and hammer to prevent distortion of the stake head (distortion may prevent grill grate from sliding onto stake)
- Grill stake should be driven at least 6" into the ground to maximize stability of the grill
- Grill stake is not to be used for any other function than supporting enclosed grill grate
- Load food onto grill grate after grate has been slid onto grill stake; grate height can be adjusted after food is loaded
- Cooking spray is recommended on the grill grate to prevent food from sticking (apply spray to grate prior to placing over fire)
- Product is not designed to carry load from cast iron skillets
- Dripping grease from cooking food will be HOT and may cause sudden sparks/flame
- Grill handle will become HOT during use; use protective glove or hot pad when handling
- To best maintain grill finish, do not use wire brush use scouring pad to clean
- To prevent mold growth, ensure the grill is completely dry prior to storage
- Allow grill to cool completely before disassembling and storing
